


### ASSEMBLY GUIDES

# Refer to the following areas throughout the instructions to assist in the assembly process:

This area is located at the top, left-hand corner of the page and indicates which tools and hardware are needed to complete the assembly steps on a page.



This area is located at the top, right-hand corner of the page and shows an image of the product with shaded parts indicating which section is being assembled.



This area is usually located in the bottom, left-hand corner of a step and indicates that special attention is needed to perform a particular part of a step.



These areas are usually located in the bottom, right-hand corner of a step and indicate that damage to the product or serious injury may occur if the caution or warning is not heeded.





Throughout the Parts & Hardware List, Part & Hardware Identifiers, and instructions are three-letter IDs. These IDs are below the images of the parts and hardware to help you locate and identify the parts and hardware during assembly. These IDs are not necessarily on the parts themselves.

#### **SITE PREPARATION**

The actual dimensions of your Raised Garden Bed (at its widest and longest points) are 48 3/4" x 48 3/4". Ensure you select a site that will accommodate these measurements with **at least 24" of additional space** for maneuvering around each Raised Garden Bed as you garden. Ensure ground is level.




Note: The Raised Garden Bed is not recommended for placement on a patio. The organic materials used may stain the concrete.

#### RAISED GARDEN BED ASSEMBLY

Connect two (2) **Bed Panels (CTJ)** by sliding the three tabs at the end of the first Bed Panel into the three slots in the end of the second Panel. Then, slide the second Bed Panel downward as shown.












Connect the second and third **Bed Panels (CTJ)** in the same manner as the first two.

Connect the fourth Bed Panel (CTJ) to the first and third Bed Panels in the same manner as the first two. Repeat this section for the second Raised Garden Bed.



#### PERFORM THIS STEP ONLY IF YOU PLAN ON USING THESE AS TWO SEPARATE BEDS

Insert a Panel Clip (CUC) between and over the adjacent nubs to hold the two Bed Panels together. Repeat this step for each corner. Repeat this step for the second Raised Garden Bed. If you plan on stacking the two Beds, skip this step and continue to the next.













Insert a **Long Panel Clip (CUE)** between and over the adjacent nubs to hold the two Garden Beds together. **Repeat this step for each corner.**

#### FROST COVER ASSEMBLY

Insert a **Frost Cover Clip (CUO)** down onto the corner of the Raised Garden Bed. Secure the Clip to the Bed using two (2) **#10 x 1/2" Pan-Head Screws (ADX)**. **Repeat this step for each Corner.** 








SEC 3.3

Insert the ends of a **Shock Corded Rod (CUN)** into the opposite inside corners of the Raised Garden Bed as shown. Set the ends of the Rod onto the two Long Panel Clips.

Insert the ends of the second Shock Corded Rod (CUN) into the opposite inside corners of the Raised Garden Bed until the top of the arc rests on the first Shock Corded Rod as shown.







Set the Frost Cover (CUL) down over the Shock Corded Rods and secure with the four Velcro strips through and around the Frost Cover Clips.




### 용 4 RAISED GARDEN BED LAYOUT




The Raised Garden Bed may be used as one double Bed for plants requiring more depth for roots, and with or without the Frost Cover.

### **CLEANING & CARE**

Congratulations on your Lifetime® product purchase. By following the instructions below, your new Lifetime product should provide you with years of service and enjoyment.

#### **Cleaning and Care**

The polyethylene panels are stain- and solvent-resistant. Most stains can be removed, using a mild soap and a soft-bristled brush. Abrasive cleaning materials may scratch the plastic and are not recommended. Repair scratches or rust spots on the metal by sanding the affected area lightly; using a rust preventative spray primer; and finally, spraying with a high-gloss spray enamel paint. Avoid placing a direct heat source on or near surfaces unless using a heat barrier.

When not using the Frost Cover and Shock-Corded Rods, store them in the bags provided.

#### 5-YEAR LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

### THE MANUFACTURER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE SUBSTITUTIONS TO WARRANTY CLAIMS IF PARTS ARE UNAVAILABLE OR OBSOLETE.

- 1. Lifetime raised garden beds are warranted to the original purchaser to be free from defects in material or workmanship for a period of five years from the date of original retail purchase. The word "defects" is defined as imperfections that impair the use of the product. Defects resulting from misuse, abuse or negligence will void this warranty. This warranty does not cover defects due to improper installation, alteration or accident. This warranty does not cover damage caused by vandalism, rusting, "acts of nature" or any other event beyond the control of the manufacturer.
- 2. This warranty is nontransferable and is expressly limited to the repair or replacement of defective product. If the product is defective within the terms of this warranty, Lifetime Products, Inc. will repair or replace defective parts at no cost to the purchaser. Shipping charges to and from the factory are not covered and are the responsibility of the purchaser. Labor charges and related expenses for removal, installation or replacement of the raised garden bed or its components are not covered under this warranty.
- 3. This warranty does not cover scratching or scuffing of the product that may result from normal usage. In addition, defects resulting from intentional damage, negligence, unreasonable use will void this warranty.
- 4. Liability for incidental or consequential damages is excluded to the extent permitted by law. While every attempt is made to embody the highest degree of safety in all equipment, freedom from injury cannot be guaranteed. The user assumes all risk of injury resulting from the use of this product. All merchandise is sold on this condition, and no representative of the company may waive or change this policy.
